**MEMORANDUM**

**Subject: Scale of Relief to be provided for damaged houses under State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).**

Items and norms of assistance from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015 conveyed by MHA, GOI vide no. 32-7/2014-NDM-I, dtd. 8th April, 2015 has been circulated to all DMs. It is clarified that the assistance in case of damaged houses may be extended as per following norms:

Item : Housing	Norms of Assistance	Remarks
a) Fully damaged/ destroyed houses	Rs.95,100/- or actual amount of damage whichever is less per house, in plain areas  Rs.1,01,900/- or actual amount of damage whichever is less per house, in hilly areas.	Pucca House: The dwellings that are designed to be solid and permanent and built of substantial material such as stone, brick, cement, concrete or timber.

b) Severely damaged house

c) Partially Damaged Houses (where the damage is at least 15%)	Actual amount of damage subject to a minimum of Rs.5,200/- for Pucca house and Rs.3,200/- for Kutcha house.  The maximum amount should not exceed the amount of assistance meant for fully and severely damaged houses.	Kutcha House: The dwellings that are made up of mud or bamboo wall with hay stack or tin roof.

- The assessment of damage should be done by an assessment team which should include Revenue Department staff and Technical person (from PWD and/or RD Engineering wing).
- DMs are hereby authorised to act as competent authority to sanction assistance as per aforesaid norms. Immediate interim relief of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) as advance shall be given to the affected families in case of severely or fully damaged house. They should take immediate steps to ensure that relief measures are extended to affected families at the earliest.
- Scale of assistance in respect of other items may be extended as per norms.
