NOTICE INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

**PROPOSAL FOR ESTABLISHING AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICES (ARES)
NETWORK IN TRIPURA**

Revenue Department, Government of Tripura, invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from reputed and specialized Amateur Radio service providers / Agencies, etc. having requisite expertise experience in providing Training and to establish Amateur Radio Emergency Services Network in Tripura. The format and other details for the EOI is available at website www.tdma.tripura.gov.in.

I:- Project Title: TRIPURA STATE-AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICES (ARES) NETWORK

II:- Background: Revenue Department, Government of Tripura intends to engage a specialized agency having experience to setup Amateur Radio Communication Network and also experience to conduct training on ASOC (Amateur Station Operator's Certificate) examination to establish Amateur Radio Emergency Services (ARES) in Tripura (preferably in State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) & 8 District Emergency Operation Centres (DEOCs)). The contract will be valid for 1 (one) year.

III:- Location of Work/Service: In SEOC & 8 DEOCs: The agency is required to conduct:

- (i) Amateur Radio Training Program
- (ii) Establishing an Amateur Radio Centre
- (iii) Amateur Radio Emergency Service Network.

IV:- Duration of empanelment: 1 (one) year extendable by 1 (one) year considering the need and approval.

V:- Method of empanelment:

- Revenue Department, Government of Tripura like to empanel reputed and specialized Amateur Radio service providers / Agencies, etc. having requisite expertise experience in providing training on Amateur Radio (ASOC EXAMINATION), arrange ASOC examination conducted by Ministry of Communication, Government of India in Tripura and also have experience on handling & establishing Amateur Radio Network. Revenue Department, Government of Tripura will follow a diligent process for selection of partner (s) for empanelment in order to implement Amateur Radio Emergency Services Network in Tripura.
- The validity of the empanelment shall be initially for a period of 1 (one) year, which may be extended by one more year with mutual agreement with the first right of refusal by Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura. This is at the sole discretion of the Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura. There shall be no binding upon the firms or the Management of Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura.
- It may be noted that a financial proposal is to submit in a separate sealed enclosure.

VI:- Scope of Work:

Tripura State Amateur Radio Emergency Services (ARES) shall establish amateur radio club centres at State, District and Local level as part of a scalable network plan, with a group of licensed amateurs who have voluntarily registered their qualifications and equipment for communications duty in the public service when disaster strikes. The government may passively regulate certain ARES club centre through formal understandings. In a typical emergency situation, an ARES group will first activate and implement predetermined plans to assist local governments.

A typical pre-disaster plan and arrangement for disaster communication includes: (1) identification of agencies who will need Amateur Radio communication services; (2) discussion with these agencies to learn the nature of the information which they will need to communicate, and the people [with whom] they will need to communicate; and (3) specification, development and testing of pertinent services. A formal written description of the communication is required for completeness, conciseness, and easier copy for operators to understand.

ARES club centre may elect/nominate/appoint an emergency coordinator(s), who runs that local ARES organization for training and re-training of its members and the interaction between ARES volunteers and local agency officials. Membership in Tripura State ARES organisation is open to every licensed amateur, where there exists a sincere desire by the individual to join. The stated goal of ARES members is to use their skills to help the local governmental agencies provide the information that needs to be passed, while at the same time showing their talents as trained communicators who know how to pass information quickly and efficiently.

Proposed ARES Club Centres: The following are the locations identified for establishing amateur radio stations with HF and VHF/UHF communication capabilities with digital/analog modes as part of the amateur radio emergencies service network of Tripura state.

A total of 9 locations have been identified for setting up of amateur radio centers/stations based on the requirement for effective and efficient disaster management.

VII:- Time Table: The achievements of the project implementation for the period of 12 months can be monitored in two phases of 8 months and 4 months.

During the first 8 months

- A) Conducting awareness programs, seminars and lectures in identified 8 locations.
- B) Training / ASOC Exam / Obtaining license for successful candidates.
- C) Preparation for procurement of equipment

During the Next 4 months

- A) Procurement and Installation of Amateur radio equipment and field training exercises to obtain necessary propagation parameters for design and development of network model.
- B) Final implementation of the network model and conducting mock exercise to train the user community on the operational mechanism of the system at fixed/ mobile location, Evaluation of reports.

VIII:- Major Milestones

- 1) Conducting awareness program to line departments and general people at large.
- 2) Conducting Training program for ASOC exam
- 3) Conduct ASOC Exam in coordination with Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India.

- 4) The amateur station operator license is issued by WPC wing, DoT, Ministry of Communications, Govt. of India to the candidate successful in the above examination.
- 5) A club station is formed at each of the location with the licensed amateur radio operators available as its participating members.
- 6) Procuring the equipment for each of the location, installation, testing, knowledge transfer and handing over

IX:- Quantity of Work:

The agency is required to conduct:

- (i) Amateur Radio Training Program (270 personnel i.e. @30 officials per location)
- (ii) Establishing an Amateur Radio Centre
- (iii) Amateur Radio Emergency Service Network.

Note: In case of damage / malfunctioning of the above equipment, the same will be repaired / replaced by the party at their own cost. Also any consumable required for the above equipment shall be arranged by the party at their own cost.

XI:-Payment Terms:

- i. Bills will be raised by the agency after conducting of Amateur Radio Training Program. Frequency of raising the bills can be mutually agreed at a later stage.
- ii. Payments are subject to completion of work as per Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura satisfaction and necessary submission of Documents.
- iii. Details of Document required to be submitted along with every invoice/bill is as below:
 - Registered CA audited utilization certificate (on the letter head of the CA) and detailed break-up of the funds received from Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura.
- iv. The agency shall be liable to bear GST and all applicable taxes as per the prevailing rates.
- v. Revenue Department is not liable to make any advance payments.

XII:-Jurisdiction & Dispute Resolution:

- a. Any Disputes/Claim arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding are subject to Arbitration and sole Jurisdiction of Court of Tripura at Agartala.
- b. In case of any dispute or differences arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding, each party may as soon as practicable give to other party notice in writing of the existence of such questions or disputes specifying its nature and the point of issue. If the parties cannot resolve the matters by mutually acceptable solutions within 30(Thirty) business days, the said dispute or difference shall be referred to and settled by arbitration under the provisions of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any re-enactments or modifications thereof.
- c. The sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura shall enter upon the reference immediately and within 60 working days from its constitution pass the final award. The time of 60 days contemplated may be extended by mutual consent of both the parties in writing.
- d. The venue of the Arbitration shall be at Agartala or any other place in Tripura mutually agreed upon and the arbitration shall be carried out in English language only.
- e. The arbitration decision shall be final, irrevocable and binding on all parties. The decision shall also determine the expenses of the arbitration and the Party shall bear them or the proportion of such expenses to be borne by each party.


XIII:-Qualifying Conditions

a. Pre-Conditions to Selection

- (i) The participants will be evaluated first on the basis of fulfillment of mandatory conditions (marked as M in the table below) as per the Qualifying Criteria. Responses submitted by the participant which do not fulfill all the mandatory conditions as per qualifying criteria, will be rejected.
- (ii) All proposals/ documents received shall be evaluated for acceptability.
- (iii) Short listed agencies shall be invited to present the proposed work plan for undertaking the services along with financial offer as per the scope of work mentioned above at Civil Secretariat, New Capital Complex in Agartala, Tripura.
- (iv) Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura shall have the rights to select a firm or reject on the basis of the above selection criteria and shall be the sole discretion of Revenue Department.

b. Agency Profile (Mandatory):

1. It is mandatory for the Agency to have their physical presence in North East India.
2. It is mandatory that the agency shall have implemented similar project on Amateur Radio Services Network for either a Public Sector Undertakings/GOI Enterprises (Central or State) or a Public Limited Company in India.

XIV:-General Conditions of the EOI

- (i) Consortium is allowed with OEM (original equipment manufacturer) of Amateur Radio Equipment/Authorised distributor/ channel partner/ dealer having valid DPL (dealer possession license) from Ministry of Communication, Government of India and having authorized service centre at Agartala, Tripura.
- (ii) For Eligibility criteria, documentary evidence is to be submitted after being duly self-attested, serially numbered and enclosed with the EOI. If the documentary proof is not enclosed for any criteria, the EOI is liable to be rejected. The decisions of Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura shall be final in all cases.
- (iii) Nature of documentary evidence should be clearly mentioned. (Like MoU Copy/Contract Copy/ Work Order Copy, etc.)
- (iv) Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura shall have the right to postpone, modify or cancel the aforesaid process at any stage at its sole discretion without assigning any reason and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon its decision.
- (v) Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura reserves the right to reject any or all applications without assigning reason thereof. Conditional, erroneous and incomplete EOIs shall be rejected out rightly.
- (vi) The evaluations of the proposals would be done by a Committee of Govt. of Tripura which may seek clarifications from bidders if felt necessary and the bidders shall clarify such aspects.
