NOTIFICATION

The Incident Response System (IRS) is an effective mechanism for reducing the scope for ad-hoc measures in response. It incorporates all the tasks that may be performed during any disaster irrespective of their level of complexity. It envisages a composite team with various sections to attend to all the possible response requirements.

2. As per the guidelines of National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), the undersigned is directed to constitute the Incident Response System (IRS) at the State level. The IRS framework indicating its team members is enclosed at **Flag A**. The specific roles and responsibilities as per the NDMA guidelines are enclosed at **Flag B**.
3. The main purpose of the IRS is to lay down the roles and responsibilities of different functionaries and stakeholders, at State and District levels and to coordinate with the multi-tiered institutional mechanisms of the State. It also emphasizes the need for proper documentation of various activities for better planning, accountability and analysis.
4. This will take immediate effect.
